#### THE RENOVATION PROGRAMME

### **Update on the Renovations:**

Although there is still some work going on, we are gradually getting the church back to normal operation. –

- lightning conductors have now been connected but the surrounds are still to be finished.
- The window frames in one of the light cannons will be sealed; the contractor thinks this may be a source of a leak we have identified in periods of very heavy rain. This is scheduled for Friday 16th September.
- We have still to fit the audioloop.
- We have increased the volume on the microphone settings and we can adjust further if necessary. (The microphones sound louder when the church is empty but people and their clothing and background noise can dampen the sound so please let us know if there are continuing problems.) We have had a minor issue with the lectern microphone so we are using a temporary solution until it is repaired.
- The sanctuary lamp, statues and Stations of the Cross are now back in place, and Paul Ellis has done magnificent restoration work on the statues and Stations. The Statue of the Immaculate Conception has been placed in the niche above the Lady Altar for a trial period.
- We will get the organ back in the next week or two, depending on when the removal can be organised. The organ has been in use in St Columba's, Viewpark during our period of renovation.
