The Requiem Mass, is the principal liturgical service of the Roman Catholic Church celebrated for the repose of the soul of a particular deceased person or persons. The term "Requiem" (rest, repose) derives from the introit or entrance antiphon of the Mass which begins with the words *"Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domine"* - *"Grant them eternal rest, O Lord"*.

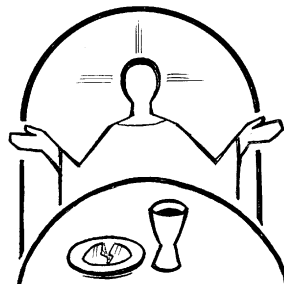
## Communion Procession

your deep abiding love.

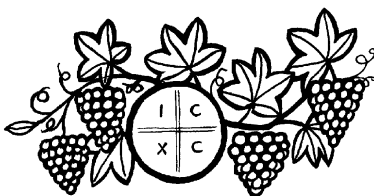
My own belief in you my Lord

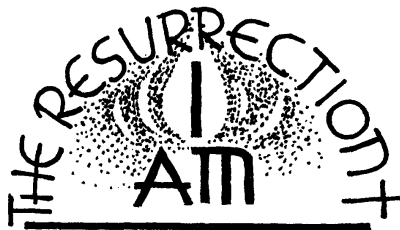
