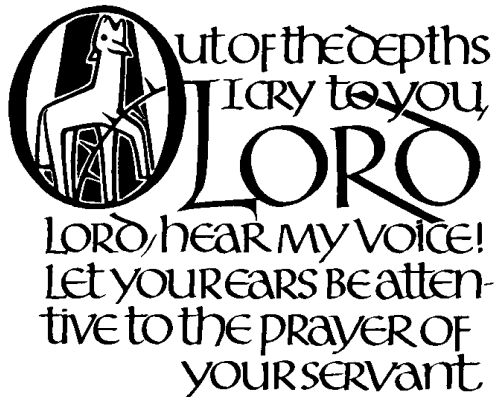

and holy is his name.

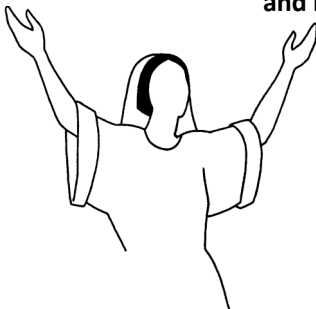
I proclaim the pow'r of God!
